Gordon Persons Building



The Gordon Persons Building is a six floor, 60,000 square foot state government office building in Montgomery Alabama making this build the second largest State Building in Alabama. The structural design concept of the Persons Building included placement of concrete columns down the center of its main corridors. The small pagodas in the foreground house stair exits from the pedestrian tunnel which runs under Union Street and connects the

Capitol to the State House. I suppose the pagodas are now the centerpieces of the Earl Speight Plaza. The left half of the envisioned structure, with the big glass bow-front section as the center element was built in the late 1980s on land purchased by Fob James and Dr Bronner.
